How and When To Make Your Payments

HOW:

STUDIO POLICIES

Waiting Room

NO FOOD or DRINK in the waiting room or studio

Broadway Arts Center is not responsible for students before/after their scheduled class.
You are responsible for staying up to date of information posted in the waiting room.

Students are not allowed in the dance room until their class is called.

Please be respectful of studio property.

Do not let children play with studio merchandise, decorations, or office supplies.

Please be on time for the start of class and for dismissal. All classes begin letting out 5 minutes early to ease the congestion in the waiting room and parking.

BATHROOMS ARE CLOSED DURING CLASS.

Class Observation

Parents / siblings / friends are not permitted in the studio unless invited.

Parents/siblings/friends may observe in the waiting room or leave/pick up at the end.

A 2-way viewing window is provided to observe classes.

To activate the 2-way window - pull shades and turn off the desk lamp.

Instructors may pull a curtain over the viewing window if it proves distracting to students.

Please be respectful to our teachers - do not disturb or interrupt their classes.

Dress Code

Studio issued dancewear and shoes are required for participation.

Broadway Arts Center provides all class uniforms and shoes.

All long hair should be pulled up. No jewelry, gum, candy or cough drops.

Students will borrow a uniform from the studio if they come to class without one.

Studio uniforms build class unity, reduce distractions, eliminate "competitive" attitudes towards appearance and help create an equal and positive learning environment.

Studio Calendar

Classes follow Studio calendar provided in this handbook and posted in waiting room.

Broadway Arts Center *roughly* follows the **Jefferson City School** calendar for *most* Holidays and breaks. We realize students who attend other school systems may have different breaks - and we welcome them to make up any classes missed due to vacations in another class within 30 days.

Breaks / Studio In-service

While students are off on breaks, the studio is hard at work with the "behind the scenes" planning for classes and our show. We are busy writing scripts, creating choreography, ordering / sorting costumes, making tickets / programs, set / lighting designs, building sets / props, editing music. This preparation time is essential for an organized, creative and professional production.

TUITION

Tuition is based on an average of 28 Classes for the season
(plus the Dress rehearsal / performance)
All Tuition and Fees are Non-Refundable and Non-Transferable.

Tuition is due the 1st of the Month.

\$10 LATE FEE applies to all payments received on/ after the 10th of the month.

Late Fees will apply to: Tuition, Performance & Costume fees

No refunds awarded for absences - no exceptions

Accounts 2 months in arrears will be denied classes until payments are made.

All tuition for the year must be paid by April 1st

Costumes and Tickets will be held until your balance for the season is paid.

Tuition payments and due dates remain the same regardless of holidays/breaks

All holidays/ breaks were excluded from tuition - along with 2 "Emergency" days (per class)
reserved for bad weather or teacher illness - see below.

Class Cancellations

Classes not held if *Jefferson City or Jackson County* schools close for bad weather.

In the event of bad weather - tune into the local Radio/Tv to find out if schools are closed

- or call the studio 706-367-7589 for class cancellations (We will not call students)

Studio can NOT reschedule classes cancelled for bad weather or teacher illness.

Two "emergency" days (per class) are incorporated in tuition - to be used for this purpose.

It is your responsibility to make up any cancelled class in another class within 30 days.

(call ahead to arrange)

Picture Day

Picture Day is a time honored tradition in the dance industry!

During this special week a professional photographer will be at the studio to take pictures of each class in their costumes and individual photos for anyone who wants them.

This is an *optional* service that we provide - you are not required to purchase pictures.

Picture Day dates and schedule will be announced in the spring

And are *usually* held on your regular class day/time

(Classes are NOT held the week of pictures.)

Class Enrollment

Classes with low enrollment or attendance may be shortened, merged or cancelled.

Minimum of 5 Students are required to run a 1 hour class

Classes with less than 5 students will be replaced with "semi-private" lessons

1-2 students will receive a $\frac{1}{2}$ hour lesson, 3-4 students receive $\frac{3}{4}$ hour lesson

Although "semi-private" lessons typically cost more - your tuition will remain the same.

Class Attendance

Students need to be present in class each week to grow and progress as dancers. Dance is an individual & team activity. When students are absent it affects the entire class. Students with poor attendance may be denied participation in the recital, switched to a lower level class, or held back the following year.

Too sick for School? Then too sick to Dance!!

For the health and safety of our staff and students-

Students who stay home from school - may NOT attend dance that day.

You may make up 3 missed classes in another class within 30 days. (call ahead to arrange)

Class Placement

Proper class placement is important to ensure that students are successful.

Students are placed by age and ability.

The first few weeks of class are considered a trial, and instructors may move students to higher/lower level classes based on their evaluation.

Class Discipline

Broadway Arts Center relies on clear, consistent class rules and boundaries with positive reinforcement to maintain class discipline. We offer gentle but firm guidance and the "Take 5" technique for students who demonstrate inappropriate behavior. We ask that parents trust our highly educated and experienced staff in handling class behavior. Please be respectful to our instructors and do NOT interfere or interrupt their classes. This undermines the teachers authority and causes added disruption. If we need your assistance we will ask! Yelling, belittling or physical actions by students, staff or parents is NEVER allowed. Disruptive/ disrespectful behavior is not tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal without refund.

Withdrawal

When you enroll in a class you are making a school-year long commitment.

And just as you would cancel your phone or cable - you must notify us if you no longer want our services or you will continue to be billed for your space, *regardless of your attendance.*

**Withdrawal for any reason, requires notifying the office in WRITING
- 30 days in advance.**

You are responsible for tuition / fees through the end of month of your 30 day withdrawal period

Tuition will NOT be pro-rated if you withdraw in the middle a billing cycle.

No refunds awarded if you withdraw before the spring performance

Spring Performance

Each spring Broadway Arts Center invites all its students to participate in an end of the year production to demonstrate their new skills. Unlike many other studios, that offer a "showcase" style recital, we offer a mini-musical! Broadway arts Center presents an original story using unique characters, sets, props, costumes, lighting and microphones on a profession stage. Although performance is an important part of a dancer's education, our priority is on education. Class time is spent building skills and technique not solely practicing "show" routines.

Our show will last about an hour. Each class will present ONE number in the show.

Students who take more than 1 hour per week will perform at least 2 numbers.

Students desiring more performance opportunities are encouraged to take multiple classes.

One costume is required for each number.

Costume/Performance expenses are INCLUDED in your tuition and are Non-Refundable and Non-Transferable

All costume, music, casting, all other performance details are the sole decision of the director and will be revealed after Winter Break so that our main focus and priority will continue to be on Education and our weekly lessons.

Costumes are ordered in December - Students who join late will only be able to perform if we are able to get a costume in time - rush delivery fees may apply.

Multiple Performances

To accommodate all our supportive fans, Broadway Arts Center may present more than one performance. Most students will perform in just ONE show, but some students may be required to perform in multiple shows. This will be determined each year by the needs of our script Your tuition includes 4 tickets (total) per family - not per show. If your child is in multiple shows the additional performance will NOT raise your tuition NOR raise the number of tickets you receive (4).

You may purchase additional tickets to any performance or consider being a volunteer.

Siblings

We know it can be difficult to schedule activities for multiple children, and we try our best to make it as easy as possible for you! To help out families we currently offer very generous discounts for sibling tuition. We also designate showtimes for each class on our schedule at the start of the season. This gives you the opportunity to choose classes that will perform in the same show and avoid additional ticket expenses. (Tuition includes **4 tickets** (total) per family - not per show. Addition tickets can be purchased.)

Performance Updates

As our season progresses, additional information or updates will be posted on the board in the waiting area. Make it your responsibility to keep abreast of this important information. It is our goal to make the performance experience organized and exciting for all involved. It's a team effort for students, their parents and Broadway Arts.

Home Study

To ensure that the students feel comfortable about their performance, we ask parents/guardians to encourage them to rehearse their choreography / lines on a regular basis. A copy of your child's dance music and printed copy of their choreography is available - a charge of \$4 per CD is required to cover expenses.

Costumes

Many hours are spent determining the correct costume for each class. They are always age-appropriate and of the highest quality possible. Unless told otherwise, costumes include all accessories (headpiece, gloves, etc.)

Distribution

Costumes are distributed when all outstanding balances for the season (including all tuition, Late fees & performance fees) are paid in full. Students should NOT wear their costume, tights, or accessories prior to Pictures/ Rehearsal/ Performance. **Deadline for all balances is April 1st .**

Sizing

Costume measuring begins in October during class time. Each child was measured to determine his/her proper costume size. Two inch allowances for growth are made for all students.

Alterations

Although rare, if alterations are needed after the costume has been distributed, they will be the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian. Alterations may be made for size only - adjustments may not alter the overall design or look of the costume.

Costume Care

Please put your child's name on all costumes, shoes, accessories and tights. Store your child's costume in a garment bag and place all accessories in a clear plastic bag. Press or steam costumes prior to rehearsal, hanging it in the bathroom with the steam from the shower works well to get out wrinkles. DO NOT wash costumes in washing machine; dry clean only (After the show)

Tights

To ensure that there are no discrepancies in color and style, ONE pair of tights are included: pink (ballet) or tan (Tap, Theater). Please do not wear before the Dress Rehearsal. Costumes with pants will NOT come with tights, but tan tights should be worn underneath. It is recommended to order an additional pair of tights incase of runs/ rips.

We will accept orders for tights up till April 1st

Shoes

Students must have the proper color/style shoes for their class for the performance. These requirements are outlined in the dress code policy in your registration brochure.

We will accept shoe orders till April 1st .

Withdrawal

No refunds will be made if a student withdraws from the program prior to the performance. If a costume has already been ordered - parent/guardian may pick it up last week of class (week after the show). Costumes left after the designated pick up time, will be considered studio property.

Makeup

Stage make-up is part of show business! Without makeup the bright stage lights will "wash out" your child and you will not be able to see them as well on stage or video. Makeup should be applied heavier than ordinary day-to-day use. You may use your own discretion on colors

All female students are required to wear make-up for the recital.

(lipstick, blush, eye-shadow, and mascara)

For male students a just little blush works well but is not required.

Hair

All hair must be neatly pulled off the face in a Bun or short Ponytail -unless otherwise notified.

Long bangs should be secured back (shorter bangs can remain as long as they are neat)

All items used for securing the hair (barrettes, clips, bobby pins, elastics) must blend with your child's hair color. Other than the assigned head piece - additional decorative items (Beads, Bows, etc.) are NOT permitted. Be sure to secure head pieces tightly - practice securing and moving around with head piece ahead of time.

Pre-Planning

Gather your costume (s), accessories, shoes, tights and makeup several days in advance so you know if something is missing or isn't right. Make a check list of all items needed and check it before you leave for the theater. Space is limited - only bring what you need.

Some additional items you may want to bring:

Extra Tights, Safety Pins, Hairspray, comb, extra bobby pins, Baby powder for Itchy costumes

Dress Rehearsal @ Seney Stovall Chapel

Each family will receive ONE dress rehearsal pass for ONE parent or guardian to accompany each student to the dress rehearsal.

All additional guests (age 3-up) at the dress rehearsal will be subject to the cost of a recital ticket (\$12)

Students MUST arrive already dressed in their costume with makeup and hair done.

(Students in multiple numbers should arrive in their First numbers costume)

The dress rehearsal allows the students to become familiar with their performance, costume, and being on stage. Lighting, music cues, set changes, microphones and all other logistics for an organized and professional performance are rehearsed so that students make the best possible impression.. We run an organized and timely dress rehearsal: your help with this process will guarantee a professional production. **Participation in the rehearsal is MANDATORY - no exceptions** Please arrive on time.

Green Room Etiquette

Students will spend more time in the green room (backstage waiting area) than on stage, so please do your best to keep them organized, occupied and clean! NO FOOD or DRINK is allowed in the green room. Students must respect others space and property in the green room. Broadway Arts reserves the right to dismiss any student who exhibits inappropriate behavior.

Costume Changes

All costume changes must be made in their classes designated area, NOT in bathroom stalls

Finale

All students will participate in the finale, which we will rehearse in class. A run-through of the finale will take place at the end of rehearsal. After which, students will be dismissed. If for any reason rehearsal runs later than expected - we will dismiss our younger classes before the finale. Classes that need additional practice may be asked to stay after.

Drop off & Pick Up - Dress Rehearsal & Show

Students must arrive DRESSED in full costume, hair & makeup done.

Parents/guardians should bring students to the **GREEN ROOM** entrance in the back of the theater (not through the auditorium) where they will be checked in at the doorway. **Parents /guardians and guests are NOT allowed in the green room.** Parents then proceed to the auditorium till students are dismissed at the end. After rehearsal parents will exit through the main exit (not through the backstage!) and check out children from the green room, in an orderly fashion.

CAMERAS at Rehearsal ONLY

Videos and photography are **ONLY** allowed at the Dress Rehearsal! No electrical outlets will be provided, so be sure your batteries are charged.

Absolutely NO Video or Cameras of any kind are allowed the day of the show:

Security guards will ask you to put ANY cameras back in your car.

Athens Video Services will provide a professional video of the performance for anyone who would like a copy. Order forms will be available prior to the show as well as at the rehearsal and show.

Auditorium Rules

No Food, Drink, or Smoking allowed.

(B.A.C is FINED by the theater if guests or students do not comply!)

NO COSTUMES IN THE AUDIENCE

Performing students are **NOT** allowed in the auditorium at any time during their rehearsal or show.
(Unless part of their performance)

Students who are not performing must bring a change of clothes to watch another show
(and must have a ticket)

NO CELL PHONES/ PICTURE PHONES

Cell phone signals interfere with our wireless microphones. Even in "silent" mode, cell phones will cause our microphones to cut out. Please leave your cell phone home or turn it completely OFF. Please remind your guests of this important rule as these microphones are very expensive to use and students deserve their performances to be heard. Picture phones are also prohibited as they too interfere with our microphones. Because this causes such serious technical problems, we ask for you and your guest's complete cooperation in this matter.

THEATER CLOSED BETWEEN SHOWS

All students, guests and volunteers must vacate the theater immediately after the show. The theater will re-open 30 min prior to next show. Saving seats for the next show is not permitted

Backstage

Family members and friends do not belong in the backstage areas or green room before/during/after at the rehearsal or show. The backstage area has limited space and is filled with delicate props and sets. To greet your dancer you must walk around the building to the back entrance. After the show there is no admittance back in the auditorium/stage.

Rehearsal & Show Ticket Policy

Passes/Tickets are required of all guests to attend Dress Rehearsal and Show.

Children under 3 yrs do not need tickets - but must sit on an adults lap.

All accounts must be paid in full before tickets will be issued.

Broadway Arts Center students need tickets to watch a show they are not performing in.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST TICKETS!

Each family may reserve up to 4 (free) show tickets and 1 rehearsal pass.

To receive your FREE TICKETS you must complete and return the Ticket Reservation Form (given out in Feb) between March 1st -April 1st

Please only reserve the amount of tickets you will use so extra tickets can go to larger families. You may request additional tickets to the Show(s) \$12 each or Rehearsal (\$6 ea) on the form.

Full payment is required to reserve /request extra tickets.

Your balance for the year must be paid to reserve extra tickets; otherwise your ticket payment will be put towards the tuition owed first. If we cannot meet your ticket request, we will issue Rehearsal Passes for your extra guests.

Extra Ticket Requests will be filled first come-first serve.

We will not accept forms before March 1st.

Need an extra ticket? Be a volunteer! (*see below)

Parent Volunteers

Volunteers WILL be able to watch their child dance from the audience! There are jobs for men and women, including collecting tickets, distributing programs, security, parking attendants, stage hands and *class moms. The performance weekend is a hectic experience; all volunteers must work in a cooperative manner at all times. Our backstage crew works very hard to put a system in place that works; we ask all volunteers to rely on our experience and follow instructions.

All volunteers will receive an identification badge which must be worn at all times while in the theater. This badge serves as your *TICKET so you may give your show ticket to someone else! **Do not bring guests, including children, with you while you are volunteering.**

A volunteer form is required and is included in this handbook. It may be returned with your ticket reservation form between March 1-April1. There will be **one mandatory orientation meeting** for all volunteers and all must abide by the policies set forth by Broadway Arts.

***CLASS MOMS**

Class mothers are needed for each class to supervise the dancers backstage. They will have a FRONT ROW seat reserved in the audience to watch their child's number. Class moms must assure that each child in their care is safe and accounted for at all times. They are responsible for making sure each child is in the proper costume, shoes, and accessories. They must line the children up properly and assist them quietly up the stairs to the backstage at the appropriate time. They will exit the side door to the auditorium and watch from their reserved seat. After the number is over, they will return their class to the green room. The number of volunteers needed is determined by class size. Volunteer positions will be filled first come-first serve. If more Moms volunteer for your class than needed you may be asked to assist with another class.

(Keep in safe place - we are not responsible for lost tickets!)
- COSTUME CARE, HAIR & MAKE UP!** SEE PARENT HANDBOOK
- ORDER your DVD!** From **Athens Video!** Order forms at the studio, dress rehearsals and shows.
Personal video cameras are allowed at the **dress rehearsal ONLY!** **No cameras at the show.**
- PRE-REGISTER** For Fall!!! (by MAY 1). To Get a **FREE T-Shirt** and guarantee your space!
- PICTURE WEEK! (see calendar)** During regular class time - come in **FULL COSTUME**

(inc. hair & Make up). Purchase is NOT required. A Parent must accompany their child to picture day. Students will be dismissed as soon as their photos are complete.

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSALS Arrive in FULL COSTUME! Please be on time!
Check-in green room $\frac{1}{2}$ hr prior to rehearsal start time. Don't Forget your Rehearsal Pass!!
Please have hair and make up done - BEFORE you arrive. Do not expect to get ready there.

SHOW!! Arrive in FULL COSTUME. Theater will OPEN 30 minutes prior to show! Check students into green room 20-30 minutes before show time. Check out immediately following each show - theater CLOSES between shows to be cleaned and reset. Reserving seats for the next show is not permitted.

THEATER RULES! Please explain these rules to all your guests ahead of time.
NO CELL PHONES (they interfere with Microphones!) **NO FOOD or DRINK or SMOKING.**
NO CAMERAS/ VIDEOS (at show) **NO ONE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE** (except staff, students & volunteers)

SUMMER DANCE CAMPS!!! Join the fun!! Don't forget to sign up for summer camp!

THEATER DIRECTIONS!!

SENEY STOVALL CHAPEL (behind "Varsity" in Athens)

Take 129s to Athens, Take Right on Mileage Ave (ga 15) (at Dunkin Donuts)

Cont. thru light. Theater (round brick building) on Right.

Park behind Chapel or at "Varsity" Restaurant (when Chapel lot is full)

Students check in (green room) around BACK. Guests use Large staircase in front.
